## Woodgate Pool Rules

- 1. Pool Hours The pool may be used between the hours of 6 AM and 10 PM.
- 2. NO KEY-NO ENTRY
- 3. Children under the age of 14 must be supervised by an adult. An adult is considered to be 18 years of age of older.
- 4. Monitor's Authority- The monitors have total authority with regard to rule enforcement.
- 5. Diapers, whether cloth or disposable, must be covered with rubber pants.
- 6. Persons having infectious diseases, open sores, bandages, cut or recent vaccinations are not permitted in the pool or pool area.
- 7. Glassware, alcohol, and chewing tobacco are not allowed in the pool area at any time. Food and beverages (except water) will be permitted in the grassy areas only.
- 8. Bicycles, trikes, skateboards, roller-skates or other play equipment are not allowed in the swimming pool area.
- 9. Pets are not allowed in the swimming pool area.
- 10. Horseplay, running, spitting, undue splashing and excessive noise are not allowed.
- 11. Frisbees and small balls are not allowed. Inflatable beach balls are allowed.
- 12. Jumping over the pool fence is not allowed.
- 13. Loud radios and cassette players are not allowed.

- 14. Adults have priority for pool furniture use.
- 15. Flotation devices may be used only if they do not interfere with other swimmers.
- 16. Guests are allowed only if accompanied by a member. Each household may not have any more than **6** guests at a time.
- 17. Trash shall be disposed of in appropriate container upon leaving the pool.
- 18. NO DIVING ALLOWED
- 19. All swimmers must wear swim attire no cutoffs or shorts
- 20. The pool is unguarded swim at your own risk. The pool monitor is not a lifeguard.
- 21. Anyone who violates these rules may have their pool privileges suspended for whatever period is deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors. Anyone causing damage to the pool facility will be responsible for the costs of repair or replacement.
