Avoid Towing—Parking Rules Reminders

The Board of Directors is aggressively pursuing the removal of abandoned or disabled vehicles in the community. According to the Association's parking resolution, this includes any inoperable, unused, unregistered (absent or expired registration tags) or abandoned vehicle that is not parked within an enclosed garage. Vehicle that have not been driven under their own propulsion for a period of three weeks or longer are prohibited to be stored in a common area parking space. Vehicles in violation will be tagged and towed at the owner's expense.

The parking resolution also states that the garages are for parking of one vehicle. The conversion or alteration of garages for other uses such as living areas, storage areas or workshop areas that hinder or prevent the parking of a vehicle is prohibited.

There are no assigned parking spaces in the community. All common area parking is on a first come, first serve basis. Please be courteous of your neighbors and make sure that you are using your garage for parking and that you are not taking up an excessive amount of the open parking spaces or storing unused vehicles in these areas.

Pet Waste Removal

The Association is paying to have a one-time cleanup of pet waste in the community. PLEASE be responsible and pick up after your pet. The Association would rather spend money to improve the community than have to clean up after irresponsible pet owners.

If you see anyone failing to pick up after their pet, please report it to the management company so they can be held accountable.

Landtech Landscape Contract Approved

The Board of Directors has approved Landtech's 2019 Landscape
Maintenance Contract in the amount of \$50,844. They will be responsible for the mowing, edging, fertilization, weed control, aeration, shrub pruning, irrigation system maintenance and general clean up of the common areas (excluding pet waste removal). 


